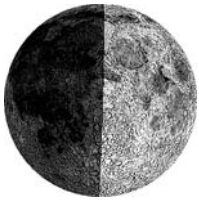

3-15-2017 @ 9:45 pm EDT

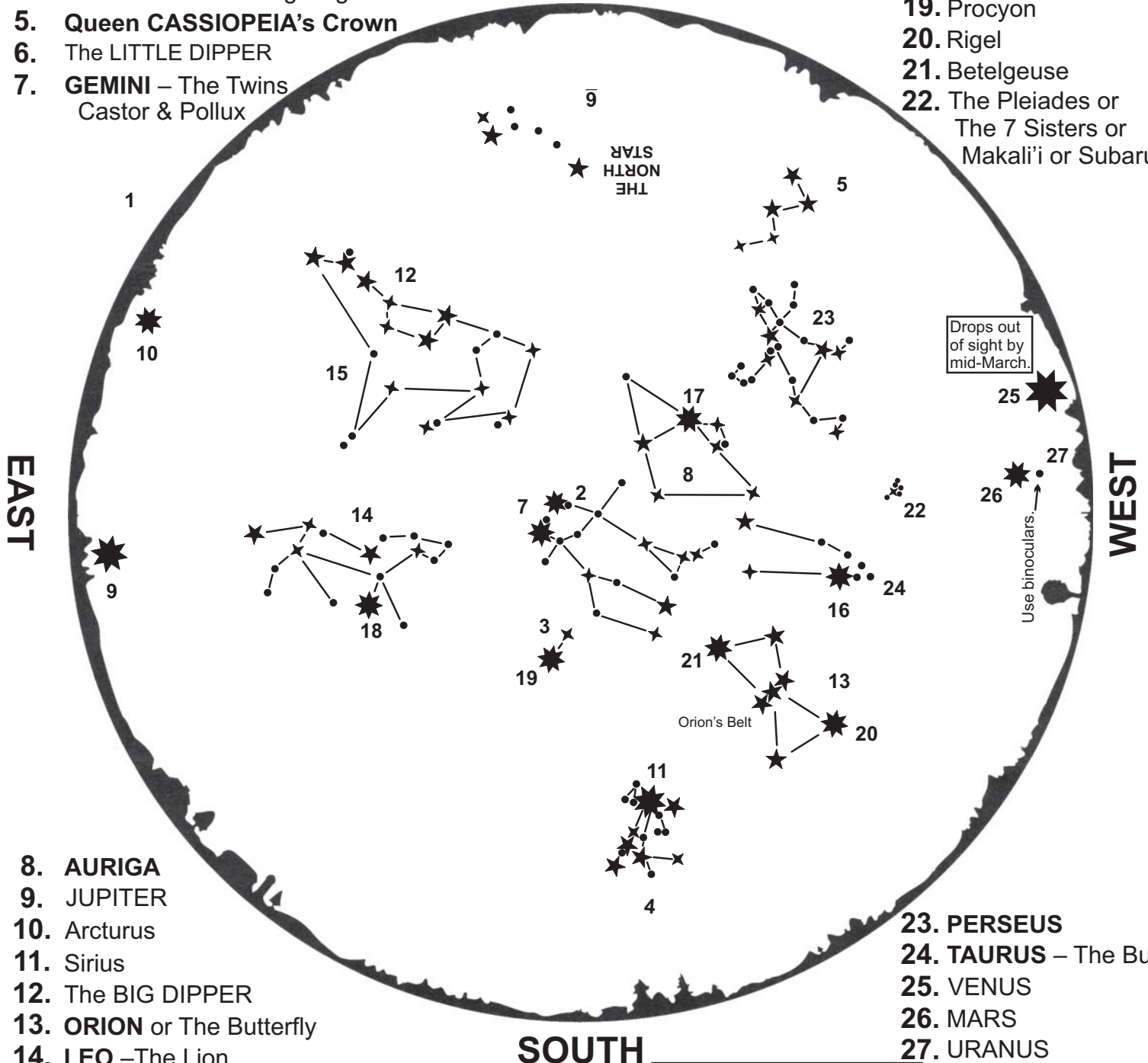
3-31-2017 @ 8:45 pm EDT
