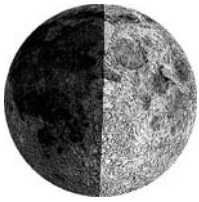

The stars come up 4 minutes earlier each evening, so this chart will be accurate on:

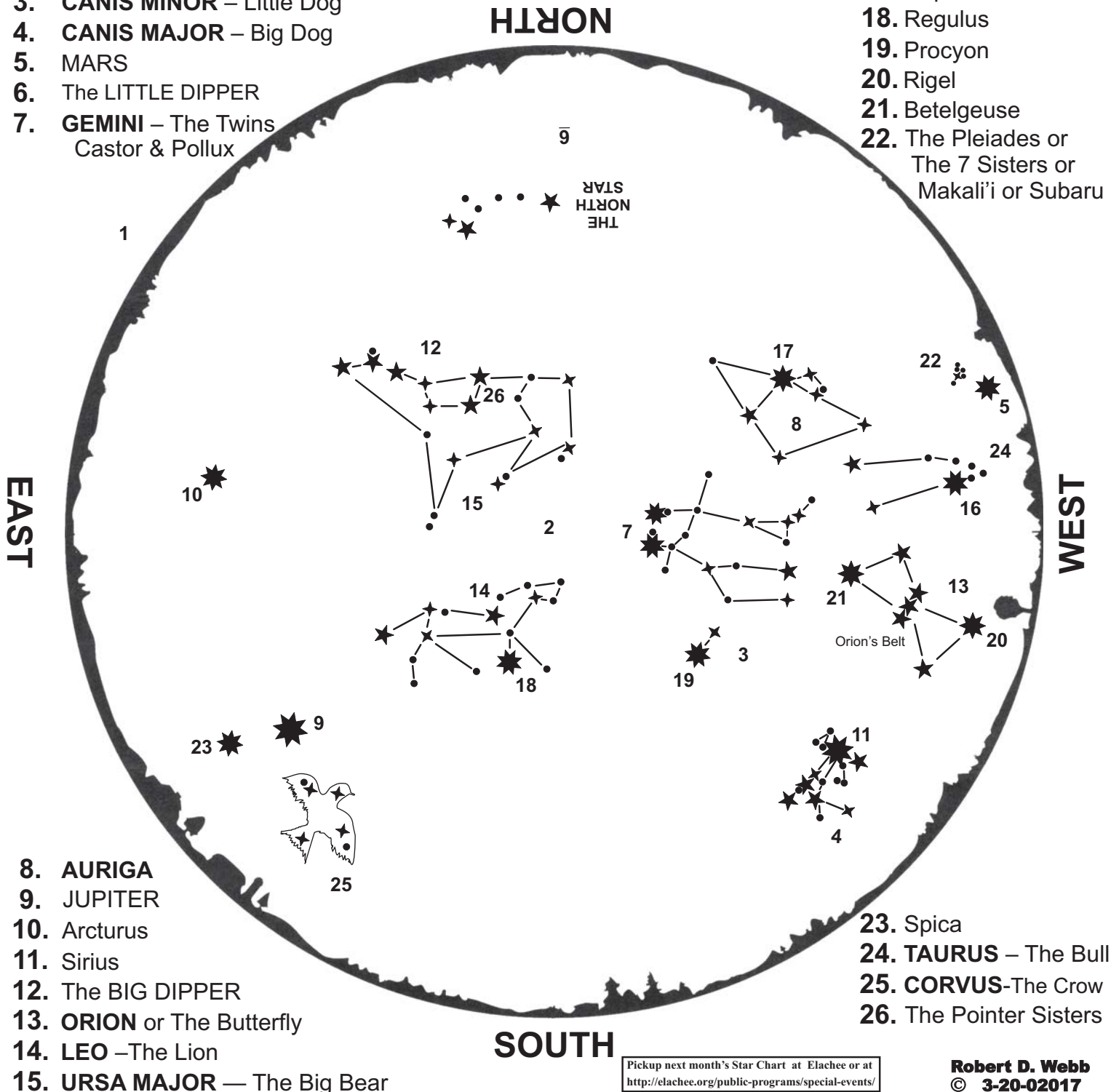
4-1-02017 @ 10:45 pm EDT
