






## 15 GEIGER TRAIL hiking trail

Interact with our resident animal ambassadors. These native species reside in carefully recreated habitats to help you become acquainted with the environments where you may encounter these creatures.


## 22 CREATION STATION activity area Let your imagination flow in this covered play area that has kitchens, chalkboards, tables and more!
