



Thank you for your interest in Elachee Nature Academy's 2026-2027 nature-based program. Parents choose our unique setting to prepare their young children for future success while recognizing that opportunities to play and explore are important building blocks for a well-rounded education. As such, at Elachee Nature Academy, our mission is to provide educational experiences in the classroom and in outdoor settings that will encourage a child's natural curiosity, inquisitiveness, affection and respect for the natural world.

Our half-day Preschool program is a nature-based educational approach that offers a variety of activities that promote pre-literacy and pre-math skills, physical growth, and social development. Our full-day Pre-K/K Readiness program builds upon the holistic approach in our preschool while also incorporating skills needed for Kindergarten. Our Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> grade programs features a specially designed, standards-based method of experiential learning which invites children to engage in creative discovery and reflection, with instruction predominantly taking place in our beautiful natural setting.

Elachee Nature Academy is accredited through Cognia and is managed and operated by Elachee Nature Science Center, a regional environmental education resource with a legacy of providing quality programming for children, adults, and families since 1979.

The Elachee Nature Academy school year begins in August and ends in May. Our program is a 10-month program, and we require a commitment for the entire school year. Half-day program hours are 8:15-12:15 and full-day program hours are 8:15-3:15.

Elachee Nature Academy reserves the right to reconfigure grade levels and classroom spaces as necessary during the enrollment period.

### **Eligibility**

Students previously enrolled in a traditional elementary school setting must be in good academic and behavioral standing. Each student applying for the Preschool or Pre-K programs must also be competent with independent bathroom skills.

Preschool: Children must be age 3 by September 1, 2026, but cannot turn age 5 before March 1, 2027.

Pre-K: Children must be age 4 by September 1, 2026.

Kindergarten: Children must be age 5 by September 1, 2026.

1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>: Children must be age 6 by September 1, 2026.

### **Elachee Nature Academy New Student Admission Process**

- Complete the New Student Application between November 17, 2025- March 2, 2026. Applications can be requested on our website
- If seeking financial assistance, apply through Pay it Forward by December 31, 2025. (PK-2<sup>nd</sup> only)
- Participate in a one-on-one interview with ENA staff.

Upon Acceptance:

Accepted families will pay the non-refundable \$499 enrollment deposit (per child) and complete the enrollment contract by March 13, 2026. Enrollment deposits will be applied to your August 2026 tuition payment. After March 13, 2026, your enrollment is binding, and you will be responsible for the entire amount of the 2026-2027 tuition cost if we are unable to fill the spot held for your child. This helps us ensure that we are able to retain the highest quality staff.

## Tuition Scale and Schedule

Tuition may be paid monthly or in one lump sum. Monthly tuition payments start the first day of the school year, with subsequent payments due on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each month, September through May. Tuition payments received on or after the 5<sup>th</sup> day are subject to a late fee.

\*As an accredited school students attending Elachee Nature Academy in grades K-2 are required to attend daily.

## **Elachee Nature Academy Statement on Independent Bathroom Skills**

Our program complies with Bright from the Start requirements, which include strict standards for changing and disposing of wet or soiled diapers or pullups, and our classrooms are not equipped to meet these standards. Additionally, when adults are busy changing a child, it takes away from learning time for all students and removes one adult from the direct supervision of and interaction with the rest of the class. Therefore, children enrolled in our programs must be competent with independent bathroom skills before attending.

Competency with independent bathroom skills means a child can do the following:

- Wear underwear, not pull ups.
- Communicate to the teachers that they need to use the restroom before they need to go.
- Alert themselves to stop what they are doing to go and use the restroom.
- Pull down their clothes and get them back up without assistance.
- Wipe themselves after using the restroom (with minimal assistance for 3-year-olds).
- Get on/off the toilet by themselves.
- Wash and dry hands.
- Postpone going if they must wait for someone to finish or if the class is away from the classroom.
- Wake up during nap time (when applicable) should they need to use the restroom.

We do understand that even toilet trained children will occasionally have accidents. By definition, accidents are unusual incidents and should occur infrequently. In these instances, the teachers will help children to change their clothes, encouraging independence as much as possible.

Additionally, teachers will ask children many times throughout the day and before nap time if they need to use the bathroom. A teacher will assist children as needed, but children should be able to complete toileting activities independently. This is an issue which protects all concerned.

If a child consistently has toileting accidents, alternate processes may be put into place, up to and including removal from the program. Please note that this procedure is not in place to shame or punish a child of inconvenience families. Rather, cleaning accidents in the preschool setting is time consuming, and this time that teacher spend attending to and cleaning accidents is time that they are not spending interacting with children and facilitating the curriculum in a safe manner.
